Suggested Arrival Date	Approx. 3 days before the mandatory introductory meeting of the International Office if offered online or in presence; otherwise it is recommended to arrive in Bremen 3-5 days before the actual starting date of lectures.

Orientation Days	Enrolment, introduction into the structure of the university some days before lectures start. Cultural orientation in Bremen during the weekend before official start of lectures.
HfK Email Account	In the process of registering as a visiting student, an individual HfK-email address is generated automatically. Students will be informed during enrolment accordingly. It is expected that visiting students use the HfK-email address for university-related communication.

Language requirements for exchange students	Exchange students are expected to have either good German <u>or</u> good English skills. B1-B2 level recommended. The official language of instruction at HfK Bremen is German, but teachers and students can give advice in English. Some courses in Digital Media are given in English.

A placement test is organized at the beginning of each semester. Please note that we cannot guarantee a place.

ECTS Information and Grading System	<p>ECTS and grades in Design and Digital Media/ no grades in Fine Arts. The workload for a full-time student is measured at 30 ECTS for one semester. 1 Credit point equals 30 hours. Exchange students are allowed to take less credits. Exchange students in Fine Arts will receive ECTS and grades if required by their home university. Exchange students should make sure to know the rules of their home university study programme.</p> <p>Grading system at HfK Bremen:</p> <p>1.0 – 1.3 sehr gut – very good 1.7 – 2.0 – 2.3 gut – good 2.7 – 3.0 – 3.3 befriedigend satisfactory 3.7 – 4.0 ausreichend – sufficient 5.0 nicht ausreichend – fail</p>
Enrolment	All visiting students are asked to pay a semester contribution of approx. 320.00 EUR. The semester contribution does not constitute a tuition fee. The amount includes the public transport ticket (approx. 200.00 EUR) valid for 6 months for all buses, trams and trains to nearby cities as Hamburg, Hannover etc. and the whole federal state of Lower Saxony. All Bremen universities made this agreement with the public transport company to the students' advantage. Also included is an obligatory contribution for the student union and the student services organisation.

VISA	We strongly advise that students take care of their necessary visa procedures in their home country. Visa and residency permit procedures depend on the nationality/residency country of the student. Visa information - Federal Foreign Office (auswaertiges-amt.de) Students have to register in Bremen with the local authorities.

Health Insurance	EU citizens can present their European Health Insurance Card. However, we recommend to take out an additional private health insurance for Germany, especially, but not only due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Students with health insurance from other countries need a certificate from a German insurance company that it is also valid in Germany. Otherwise the student needs to take out insurance with a German insurance institution. Students receive information on the process via email from the International Office at HfK Bremen.
Accommodation	Limited number of places in student dormitory (6). Finding private accommodation is supported by student assistants, however it is the exchange students' responsibility to find a room.
